



#### RAY BERNARD

After retiring from the FBI, he created a training company that offered law enforcement officers advanced human trafficking investigations courses. He currently is an anti-trafficking expert witness for Break The Chain, LLC.

Greg will be discussing the following:

- Evolution of knowledge and training on human trafficking for law enforcement;
- Evolution of knowledge and training on human trafficking for businesses and security personnel; and
- Opportunities and challenges specifically for law enforcement and security personnel in detecting, preventing, and responding to suspected human trafficking incidents.

Ben is a registered architect with a NCARB Certification and serves as Director of Design for MCK Architecture where he is involved in the majority of the firm's projects during the schematic and design phases in a multi-office firm. With over a decade of experience working on a variety of building types including Educational, Commercial, Multifamily Housing, and Development, he brings a diverse experience to every project he is a part of.



#### MICHAEL D'ANGELO, CPP, CSC, CHPA

Michael is the lead consultant for Secure Direction Consulting, LLC, an independent security consulting firm located in South Florida. He is a board certified security consultant who has been in the public safety and security industries for over 30 years. Prior to becoming an independent security consultant, Michael worked in corporate security management in healthcare for almost a decade with Baptist Health South Florida, one of the largest healthcare systems in in the Southeast United States. While at Baptist Health, he developed and presented one of the first workplace violence prevention programs designed for the healthcare industry.

Originally, Michael transitioned into security management after a progressive and successful career in law enforcement. He is a retired Captain from the City of South Miami, Florida police department, where he served for over two decades.

Michael is a published author of a book and multiple articles in several noted security management publications. He is a regular speaker to organizations throughout the country and is frequently called upon by local news outlets to offer insight into current events relating to security, law enforcement, and workplace violence.

Michael's consulting practice includes conducting security vulnerability assessments for a variety of organizations, teaching workplace violence prevention programs, and he also serves as a court qualified expert witness in litigation involving matters of security negligence.



#### PEDRO P. ECHARTE, III

Having interned with The Haggard Law Firm as a law student in 2008, Pedro P. Echarte III rejoined the firm as an associate in October 2013. Mr. Echarte handles an array of cases for the firm, including negligent security, sex abuse, products liability, electrocution, admiralty, other catastrophic personal injury cases.

In 2016, Mr. Echarte litigated a negligent security case involving a young father who was shot 6 times in an attempted home invasion at a condominium

located in Miami. As a result of the crime, the 22-year-old was rendered an incomplete paraplegic. Echarte was able to earn a \$10.6 million dollar settlement result for the Haggard Law client and his family.

In 2020, Mr. Echarte represented five young women in a Title IX case against the Miami-Dade County School Board, stemming from allegations that a teacher had sexually abused them for years. By suing the MDCSB under Title IX, a federal statute prohibiting discrimination on the basis of gender in educational facilities, he was able to get around the statutory caps on damages in Florida against government entities. The cases settled globally for \$8.75 million dollars.

In 2022, Mr. Echarte litigated a maritime case and brought suit on behalf of a wife who lost her husband after he was run over by boat while swimming off of a public beach in Florida. While the boat operator had limited insurance coverage, Mr. Echarte sued a nearby watersports rental company for the negligent placement of buoys near the public swim area. Mr. Echarte contended that the manner in which the buoys were placed funneled passing boat traffic into the public swim area, which contributed to the tragic incident. The case against the watersports company settled shortly after the lawsuit was filed for \$3.25 million dollars.

Mr. Echarte has been named to the Best Lawyers in America List, Super Lawyers List, and was named to Florida Trend's Legal Elite. Mr. Echarte also serves on the board of the Miami-Dade Trial Lawyers Association and on the board of Kristi House, a children's advocacy organization that provides treatment and therapy to children that have been victims of abuse, including sexual abuse.

Upon graduating from University of Miami School of Law in 2010, Mr. Echarte began his career practicing commercial litigation as an associate at Greenberg Traurig. From 2011 to 2012, he served as a law clerk to the Hon. Adalberto Jordan on both the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. At the end of his clerkship term, Mr. Echarte joined the law firm Boies, Schiller & Flexner, practicing primarily in the areas of commercial litigation and antitrust.

Mr. Echarte returned to The Haggard Law Firm in 2013 as an associate and was promoted to partner in 2019.

Mr. Echarte received his Juris Doctorate from the University of Miami School of Law in 2010, graduating magna cum laude and serving as a member of the University of Miami Law Review. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in 2006 from Bucknell University where he double majored in business management and philosophy.



**CHRIS HILLS** 

Chris Hills is the program manager for the architects, consultants, and engineering (ACE) program at Bosch. He is responsible for working closely with the ACE community to provide the support and tools they need to make it easier to specify Bosch products. Chris has extensive experience in the security industry and related fields. He began his career serving as a Military Police Officer in the U.S. Army and subsequently founded an early IP video management system company that was later acquired. David is a retired Detective Sergeant and 30-year veteran of the Phoenix Police Department, where he specialized in organized commercial crimes and illicit trade. Over his career, he conducted or directly supervised thousands of complex investigations across dozens of industries. This work led to the seizure of over 100 million dollars in cash, stolen goods, and contraband from a wide range of criminal organizations.

During this time, David also owned several businesses in the retail and service sectors. He coupled his business experience and police expertise to conduct unique research with the Department of Justice and Arizona State University. David's research focused on the business of crime, formally known as the Shadow Economy. Through research, David was able to document how the shadow economy destabilizes communities and contributes to urban decay. This groundbreaking work, coupled with David's real-world experience, has made him an internationally recognized expert on shadow economics. Training police, public, and private sector leaders from over 80 countries.

Now, David is the CEO of the Center on Shadow Economics (501c3 not-for-profit organization). In this role, he works with private and public sector leaders, building partnerships and the capacity to understand and engage the shadow economy in communities worldwide.



#### DR. KIMBERLY MEHLMAN-OROZCO

Kim is an accomplished survey methodologist, research scientist, and quantitative & qualitative consultant on issues related to human trafficking. She is a leading expert witness and subject matter expert on human trafficking in the United States. Her work is published in books, peer reviewed journals, magazines, and news outlets. She has served as a peer reviewer for human trafficking publications and taught human trafficking material at the #1 ranked criminology school in the country, University of Maryland College Park. She is currently the CEO of Break The Chain, LLC and serves as the Director of Freedom Light. Kim will be discussing the following:

- Historical overview of human trafficking and the intersection with commercial sex;
- Summary of extant legislation and practices to combat trafficking;
- State of the science research on the efficacy of human trafficking interventions; and

 A general overview of opportunities and challenges for the prevention of trafficking crimes, as well as the detection of victims and offenders (e.g., high rates of misidentification (low sensitivity and specificity); misguided and erroneous "red flags"; and secondary exploitation).

Alan Carroll (A.C.) He was later recruited by two Fortune 100 companies to manage, prepare, and execute advertising and marketing programs targeting areas of South Florida.

A.C. continues to donate a significant amount of time to mentoring students throughout the state of Florida including elementary, high school, undergraduate and law school levels. He is a member of several professional organizations, including the Broward County Bar Association, T.J. #### **JUDGE LOURDES SIMON**

Judge Simon is a Circuit Court Judge currently assigned to the Civil Division of the 11th Judicial Circuit in Miami-Dade County, Florida. Judge Simon's judicial experience includes presiding as a County Court Judge from 2010 through 2017 where she worked in the Civil, Criminal and Domestic Violence Divisions. In 2017, she was appointed to the Circuit Court bench and assigned to the Criminal Division where she worked from July, 2017 through December, 2020.

During her time in Criminal Court, Judge Simon presided in both the trial division as well as the Mental Health Diversion Court. The Mental Health Court was established over ten years ago as a diversionary court for nonviolent offenders with mental illnesses or co-occurring substance disorders. Judge Simon has presided over hundreds of jury and non-jury trials.

Before her appointment to the bench in 2010, Judge Simon practiced criminal law for sixteen years in Miami-Dade County as an Assistant Public Defender. She tried over 70 felony jury trials and supervised dozens of Assistant Public Defenders as a Senior Supervising Attorney and Training Attorney. Her trial experience ranges from County Court misdemeanors to capital homicide cases.

During the past 28 years, Judge Simon has been involved in various volunteer bar associations including the Florida Association of Woman Lawyers, Cuban American Bar Association, and the Dade County Bar Association. Additionally, Judge Simon is a Florida Supreme Court appointed committee member on the Trial Court Judicial Workload and Time Study Committee; member of the 11th Judicial Circuit Fairness and Diversity Panel; Past Committee Member of the 11th Judicial Circuit Professionalism Panel; Teen Court Volunteer; and Faculty Educator/ Trainer at the Annual Conference of County Court Judges and Phase I Judicial College. Additionally, Judge Simon was trained by the National Institute for Trial Advocacy (NITA) and she utilizes her training to teach law students at the University of Miami, School of Law where she is an Adjunct professor in the Litigation Skills Program. She has been teaching criminal and civil pretrial litigation since 2009.

Judge Simon received her Bachelor of Science degree from Florida International University in 1991 and her Juris Doctor degree from Nova Southeastern University, Shepard Broad Law School in 1993.



#### KENNETH S. TRUMP, MPA

Ken is the President of National School Safety and Security Services, a Cleveland-based national firm specializing in PreK-12 school security, emergency preparedness, litigation consulting, and related safety consulting and training. He is one of the most widely quoted school safety experts, appearing on all national news networks and cable TV, and in top market newspapers.

Ken is a four-time invited Congressional witness testifying on school safety and emergency preparedness issues, and he testified on the role of the federal government in bullying at a hearing of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights. #### ALAN W. ZAJIC, CPP, CSP


